Thank you for your interest in being a CIT at Camp Shemesh this summer. CITs enrich camp by contributing their energy and talents and acting as role models for campers. The CIT program provides a bridge whereby previous campers can share their spirit while they develop the leadership skills necessary to become counselors in future years. This is essential to the continuity of our camp program.

Responsibilities include:

- assisting the head counselor and other counselors in supervision of camp activities
- helping prepare for and clean up after activities
- arriving at camp on time every day and notifying the director if you're unable to attend camp
- following the directions of the head counselor and other staff
- helping enforce the rules and policies of the camp as they apply to campers' health and safety
- acting appropriately and responsibly **at all times**

Please fill out the enclosed application and return it to the above address.

CITs must be at least 12 years of age, have completed the sixth grade, and have experience as a Shemesh camper (unless given special permission by the Camp Administrator). CITs must honor the above-mentioned responsibilities and be able to make a two-week commitment. Tuition for CITs per one-week session is \$70 for registrations received *before* April 1st. This fee includes snack, lunch, and a camp T-shirt. Registrations received *after* April 1st are subject to a \$10 late registration fee.

We will make decisions regarding CIT applications on a rolling basis beginning March 15th. Once an applicant has been accepted, a notification letter and registration form will be mailed home.
